Dear Year 10 Parents and Carers

I hope you all managed to get some rest and enjoy the lovely weather over the half term week.

As you are aware, I wrote to all parents just before half term following the Government's announcement about the cautious and phased re-opening of school provision from June 1st, starting with Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. As well as our on-going provision for those children of critical workers and other priority students who have been attending school since the "lockdown" began, we are now in a position to share with you the support that we are able to put in place for our Year 10 pupils from the **week beginning 15th June 2020**.

The Government has stated that schools should offer this face-to-face support to supplement the remote education of Year 10 pupils, which should remain the predominant mode of education during this term. They have also stated that schools should ensure that only a quarter of pupils in Year 10 are in school at any one time.

From Monday 1st June, **all** Tutors will be contacting their Tutees by phone to touch base and offer further support; but in order to allow us to start the phased return of Year 10 pupils in a safe and practical way we have planned the **following programme**:

- We will have only 2 Tutor Groups per day on site
- Each Tutor Group will then be split in half and allocated a specific classroom and outside space
- Pupils will have an allocated entrance in and out of the building and allocated toilets for that "bubble of pupils" to use throughout the day
- Each pupil will have their own computer / work space to use
- Each group will have access to a subject specialist in English, Maths, Science and EPR in the first instance and the opportunity to have some fresh air and exercise with the PE team
- Each subject will focus on any gaps in learning, where pupils may have struggled with content and then help them to move forward
- We will look to widen this provision if we are able to do so in a safe manner, maintaining minimum movement and contact
- The Key Stage team and other members of staff will also be available for any students who need 1:1 support with any aspect of their emotional health and well-being

Minimising Risk

This plan will allow us to:

- Limit movement around school
- Minimise contact and mixing, as far as possible, by keeping pupils in small groups for face-to-face support and keeping those groups as consistent as possible whilst in school
- Alter the school environment (e.g. changing classroom layouts so desks are further apart or dividing groups into different classrooms)
- Follow the government's clear hygiene guidelines
- Encourage pupils to wash their hands on a regular basis using running water and soap
- Ensure focused and thorough cleaning of frequently touched surfaces within the allocated classrooms including desks, keyboards, door handles etc at the end of each day
- Reduce the number of pupils who need to use transport to access school, so that they can socially distance whilst on the bus



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Key Information

- The support will run from **9.00am to 1.00pm**
- Transport will be available at the beginning and end of the sessions for those that normally travel on buses
- *Information can be found below for allocation of day, entrance and room for each group*
- Pupils must bring their own water bottle/drink
- Pupils must bring their own snacks or any food they want to eat
- Pupils **DO NOT** have to wear their school uniform
- They should wear clothing suitable for more physical activity for when they have their timetabled slot with the PE team

Symptoms

- If your child or a household member displays any COVID-19 symptoms, they **must not** come into school and will need to self-isolate following the government guidance:

Attendance

- We do understand that everyone's circumstances are different, parents may not want their child to access this support and may decide not to send them into school. No action will be taken against parents or carers who make this decision
- Home learning will continue to be set for pupils who are not in school and access to that learning / feedback will not change
- From week beginning **1st June 2020** your child's tutor, via a telephone call, will touch base, and offer support so that we can plan effectively
- **Please inform them whether your child will be attending school on their allocated day, and whether or not they need transport in order to get to school.**
- If you indicate that your child will be in school but they are unable to attend for any reason, please notify us by leaving a message on the attendance line or by calling school direct
- If you have told us your child **will** be attending and they subsequently do not attend without a valid reason, we will contact you as soon as possible

Please discuss with your child the importance of adhering to and respecting all the social distancing measures that are in place, whether out and about in the community or in school.
